Our Communities

TODDLER COMMUNITY AGES 12 TO 17 MONTHS

Classroom

The classroom is designed to create a safe, comfortable learning triangle between teachers, students, and the environment. This setting encourages freedom, independence, and a sense of order.

Language

Naming objects, describing actions and intentions, discussing pictures, engaging in conversation, music, singing, and learning sign language all lay the groundwork for mastering language.

Fine-motor skills

Safe space to move, build muscle tone, explore, and develop through guided activities that enhance hand-eye coordination, dexterity, and independence in a child-led environment.

Social skills

Group activities, role modeling, practical life exercises, grace and courtesy lessons, free play, and guided problem-solving that promote empathy, cooperation, and respect.



PRE-PRIMARY COMMUNITY AGES 18 TO 36 MONTHS

Classroom

Classrooms are designed with child-sized furniture, reading spaces, and accessible amenities. Teachers guide students in maintaining organization and cleanliness, teaching responsibility and care for materials.

Learning & Skills

Developing proficiency in activities like cutting, balancing, spooning, sorting, carrying, matching, shape discrimination, recognizing emotions, and self-care which is crucial for overall growth and development.

Independence

Children are encouraged to engage in practical life tasks such as pouring, dressing themselves, and cleaning up. Teachers offer guidance and support as children learn to do things for themselves, promoting confidence and self-reliance.

Academic Milestones

Children further develop language skills while exploring basic concepts in math, science, geography, reading, and writing. As "knowledge bearers," they progress at their own pace, guided to form real-world connections and think critically.

PRIMARY COMMUNITY AGES 3-6 YEARS OLD

Classroom

The Reggio Emilia approach emphasizes children as active participants in their learning. The environment is designed to feel like home, fostering flexible learning through individual or small group work.

Language

Enhance communication abilities in a multilingual environment: English, Spanish, Mandarin, and ASL. Develop reading comprehension skills, learning to understand and interpret grade-level texts, make predictions, and draw conclusions.

Academic Milestones

Students learn to identify numbers, apply mathematical concepts, recognize geometric shapes, explore cultural/social studies, study geography, delve into physical/life sciences, investigate history, and utilize IXL Learning resources.

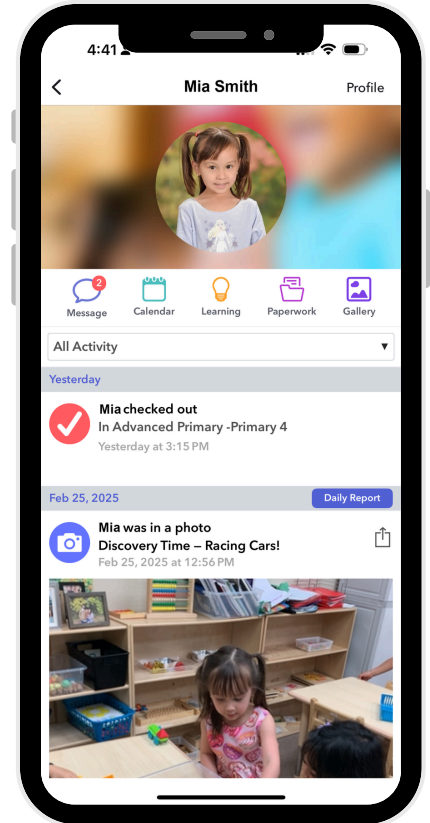
